

Roses on Structured Water Give a Glorious Show of Color

This spring 2012 we put our structured water "Large Garden Unit" to the test on our rose bushes. Living in Arizona where spring starts a little earlier, we began to water the roses on a weekly schedule starting in late March while it was still cool out during the day.

On April 28, 2012 we were already getting some roses as you can see in the picture, so we decided to begin watering every day. With daily watering, everything just went nuts! Nine days after starting to water daily, on May 6, 2012 (see pictures on the right side of the page) the rose bushes were exploding like fireworks with amazing color, and the sweetest aroma!

The change and growth you see in the pictures below took place in just 9 days of daily watering using a structured water unit. What could it do for your garden?
